# Dog Care & Training Department

**\*\* Use the special 'D' Dog Show Entry Form \*\* Please use a separate form for each animal. \*\***

This dog show is designed to be a learning experience. Judges will give you helpful pointers to encourage your improvement.

## **DOG CARE / TRAINING RULES:**

- Exhibitors must be currently enrolled in the Dog Care / Training Project.
- Dogs exhibited can be any mixture or purebred.
- Female dogs in season may not be shown.
- Dogs must be licensed, with proper verification of current Rabies and all other vaccinations including Parvo (Corona and Bordetella are strongly recommended).
- Exhibitors: Primary (Age 5-8 as of 12/31/11), Junior (Age 9-10 as of 12/31/11), Intermediate (Age 11-13 as of 12/31/11), and Senior (Age 12-19 as of 12/31/11).
- Two obedience divisions per exhibitor.
- One showmanship division per exhibitor.
- One agility division per exhibitor.
- Exhibitors are responsible for watering and cleaning up after their dogs.
- Dogs must not be left unattended.
- Any dog abuse will result in immediate disqualification.
- If a member is using a dog that they did not train from a puppy, the dog must be shown at the dog's highest level of achievement by the Youth.
- **Dogs are not allowed in buildings, food areas or around the livestock area unless they are service dogs.**
- **Dogs must be caged or kenneled when not in the show ring and can be at the dog area or campground area only.**

## **GENERAL REMINDERS FOR THE SHOW DAY:**

- Grooming and bathing should be done at home a day or two before. Just bring a brush for touchup.
- Water dishes are a must and a jug of water for your dog.
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
- As the weather could be warm, choose some shade for your dog and keep him quiet before his class. Rings will be in the sun. A spray bottle with water is good for misting your dog down.
- You are responsible for cleaning up after your dog. PLEASE bring a baggie or two.
- As fleas can be a problem, it is advisable to spray your dog before coming to the show.

# **DOG OBEDIENCE AREA**

## **Division 239: Introductory Dog Obedience**

For members and dogs who have never shown in a 4-H or sanctioned obedience class. Exercises will be: heel, figure eight, stand for examination, recall, 30 second sit and 90 second down. All exercises on a leash.

## **Division 240: Beginning Dog Obedience (A)**

For members and dogs who have shown once previously and are unable to do off-leash work. Exercises will be: heel, figure eight, stand for examination, recall, 30 second sit and 90 second down. All exercises on a leash.

## **Division 241: Beginning Dog Obedience (B)**

For members and dogs who have shown more than once previously and are unable to do off-leash work. Exercises will be: heel, figure eight, stand for examination, recall, 30 second sit and 90 second down. All exercises on a leash.

## **Division 242: Experienced Dog Obedience**

For members and dogs who have not obtained a qualifying score (170+) in an AKC/AMBOR show.. Exercises will be: on and off leash heel, figure eight, stand for examination, recall, one minute long sits and three minute long downs.

## **Division 243: Novice Dog Obedience**

Exercises will be standard AKC routine: on and off leash, including one minute long sits and three minute long downs.

## **Division 244: Graduate Novice Dog Obedience**

Exercises will be on and off leash heeling, off leash figure eight, three minute long sits with handler out of sight, and drop on recall.

## **Division 246: Dog Showmanship**

For members and dogs who are learning to handle dogs for conformation shows.

# **DOG AGILITY AREA**

## **Division 247: Introductory Dog Agility**

For members and dogs who have never shown in a 4-H or sanctioned agility class. Exercises will include: tunnels, jumps, tables, chutes, and may include dog walk, teter and weave poles.

## **Division 248: Beginning Dog Agility**

For members and dogs who have shown in a 4-H or sanctioned agility class, but not obtained a qualifying score. Exercises will include: tunnels, jumps, tables, chutes, and may include dog walk, teter and weave poles.

## **Division 249: Experienced Dog Agility**

For members and dogs who have shown in a 4-H or sanctioned agility class and obtained a qualifying score. Exercises will include: tunnels, jumps, tables, chutes, and may include dog walk, teter and weave poles.

## RABBIT AREA: (ARBA Sanctioned Show)

The [American Rabbit Breeders' Association](#) recognizes Youth Expo as an official show. Rules, definitions and judging procedures as prescribed in the latest edition of the Guide Book and Standard of the American Rabbit Breeders' Assoc., Inc., shall apply to all rabbit shows, provided they do not conflict with any of the rules and regulations prescribed the Department of Food and Agriculture.

### RABBIT AREA RULES:

1. **All animals must be identified by permanent ear marking (in the left ear)** conforming to the entry form on arrival at the show. Any duplication of ear marking by one exhibitor in the same division must be eliminated and change recorded on the judging sheet before judging.
2. Animals will be shown and judged in the proper division and class for breed, variety, age and sex only. If no division is offered, no awards may be made. Rabbits that are disqualified because of permanent defects, deformities or blemishes and those absent at the time of judging do not count when computing the number of exhibitors in the class.
3. A judge may eliminate (excuse) a rabbit from competition because of temporary or curable defects by the rabbit should be counted as an entry.
4. The All Other Standard Divisions of Heavy Weight and Lightweight Breeds will apply to all standard breeds as prescribed by the latest edition of the American Rabbit Breeders' Association, Inc., Guide Book.
5. There is not a crossbreed class.
6. Use a separate entry form for each species (i.e. rabbits, cavies and poultry.) Please weigh your rabbits and see that they are entered in the proper division. Overweight or underweight rabbits will be eliminated from division. List the Breed, Ear Number, Division and Class Numbers of each rabbit on the entry form. Rabbits are entered both by age and weight. Underweight seniors **MAY NOT** be entered in junior classes; overweight juniors **MAY** be entered in senior classes. No entry changes will be made except ear number changes or scratches. **No entry changes will be accepted after April 1.**
7. The exhibitor shall have ownership in the rabbit for the rabbit to be judged.
8. Exhibitors must clean in and under their coops before they check out. No ribbons will be given out until this is complete.
9. No dogs allowed in the livestock area.
10. No sale of animals on the fairgrounds.
11. No lactating or pregnant does with litter.
12. No straw or other bedding in cages.

1. One entry form per exhibitor. Youth exhibitors must reside in Orange County or Region 3 of the National Pygmy Goat Association.
2. The entry fee is \$5.00 per goat per class. **Make checks payable to 'Orange County 4-H'**. Check or money order must accompany entry form. (There will be a \$20.00 service charge for returned checks.) Entry fees are non-refundable.

**SHOW RULES**

1. This is a sanctioned show. NPGA Rules to govern and take precedence over all others.
2. Only N.P.G.A. registered animals may show in sanctioned classes. **Original** Registration papers must accompany goat at all times.
3. This is a youth only show age 19 and under. All exhibitors must wear their official uniform while showing (4-H, FFA, Grange). Independent exhibitors must wear white shirt and pants.
4. Pens available on a first come, first served basis. Pen space is limited. Pens are not baby/kid proof or jump proof. Please provide your own cover for your pen and/or plastic netting.
5. Bedding will not be provided.
6. Water must be available for animals at all times.
7. Health check: Only healthy animals may be entered; any animals having runny noses and/or eyes, coughs or other obvious signs of illness will be requested to leave. The decision made by the show committee is final and entry fees will not be refunded.
8. Proof of ownership shall be the name on the registration certificate. When applicable, a transfer of ownership dated within 90 days of the show and presented with the original registration certificate is required for proof of ownership.
9. Tattoo and/or microchip and registration must match entry form. Goats 6 months of age or older must have either a legible tattoo or microchip recorded by NPGA prior to being shown.
10. Wethers without a registration certificate to be judged should be a purebred Pygmy Goat. NPGA Registration numbers of the sire or dam must be presented as proof of Pygmy lineage.
11. Will allow two (2) substitutions only; however, will allow no additions or substitutions the day of show.
12. Exhibitors are responsible for entering and showing their goats in the right class.
13. Violations of the above rules may result in disqualification.

There is **limited** camping at the fairgrounds for an additional \$25 fee. Camping applications available on request, and **must be reserved by March 16<sup>th</sup>**. Do not bring big motorhomes or trailers larger than horse trailers the day of the show; there is no room to turn them around. Food vendors and exhibits will be available on show day.
